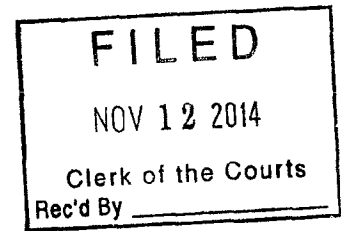

ORDER

The Tennessee Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers (“TACDL”) has filed a motion requesting leave to file an amicus curiae brief supporting the defendant’s position in this appeal and has conditionally filed with the Appellate Court Clerk’s Office six copies of the brief it proposes to file. Although the parties have already presented oral argument to this Court, neither the State of Tennessee nor the defendant objects to TACDL’s motion.
